Decision

The incidents denote that the National Security Apparatus and the Intelligence, Department of Combating Terrorism, have transferred to us, the procedures' file of the suspect/ ABOUSFIAN, who was detained there (at their detention places), and that after his going on a hunger strike.

After interrogation and investigation conducted by the attorney general, the following facts were disclosed:

- The suspect does not belong to any political, partisan, sectarian party or otherwise based on religious, political, ethnic, sectarian or partisan understanding.

Thus, what have been arisen around the suspect were merely doubts on his general shape, beard, prayer's mark on his forehead and his neighboring to those who belong to Al-Qaida in Canada and doing prayers in groups with them at the same mosque of the area. He was known for reading the Koran in different groups for the purpose of treatment, a matter that made him famous and attracted to him followers. In addition, his name -that starts with "Abu" is similar to Al-Qaida member surnames. As regards his being one of Al-Qaida members, this - according to our own investigations- is never possible, as his nature, education and nurturing do not belong to this organization, and his being present here or there and his

movement here or there does not bear any great threat to the society nor to the individuals, neither does it bear any threat to any international interests. Based upon our investigations, we did not find any evidence that allow condemning or punishing him.

And, as the data is not enough for suspecting him, I. hereby decide the following:

- 1- Dropping the procedutes VS ABOUSFIAN ABDELRAZIK
- 2- Releasing him instantly and for ever.
- 3- Keeping the documents.
