Myriam has been calling every week in order to get an update. When she called yesterday, we discussed the overall difficulties in this case. I explained that the airlines refused to take him, not just Lufthansa but others. She does quite understand it. She asked was other options are available, I told her that it was difficult to say since we were not sure what would be available. We discussed by sea but I told her that we did not know if Sudanese authorities would allow it.

She came to the conclusion that perhaps a private charter plane may work. We discussed prices and I told her how much it cost for a medical repatriation (approx \$70,000-80,000) but that a non-medical plane would be much cheaper though still expensive. I told her that the gov. would not pay for this. She said she would do some research and see how it could work. She thought that perhaps family and friends would help, she may be able to get a bank loan, etc.. [REDACTED] s.26

So, should she get a private plane, there is very little we could do to stop him from entering Canada. He would need an EP and I guess this could be refused but on what ground.
